Keep dogs on a lead except under judges' instructions.
Spectators and Competitors must consider themselves under the control of the Stewards at all times. Dogs arriving after the judging has commenced will not be allowed to run without the permission of both judges and organisers.
All dogs must be registered on their BREED register with the KC.
