- Judges: Mrs M Nixon (A2158), Steve Robson, Peter Guest, Ray Fairbrother
- Entry Fee: Members £6.00 per dog per test, non members £10.00 per dog per test (why not become a member, this is £8.00 single & £12.00 joint) made payable to 'Coventry & District Gundog Society'.

- Awards: Trophy for 1st place in each class and permanent mementos and cards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places. The Bardontop Trophy for highest placed C&DGS member.
- Definitions: **Puppy:** Confined to dogs less not older than 18 months of age on the day of the test.
Novice: Confined to dogs which have not gained an award or a COM at a Field Trial or first, second or third in an open GWT or a first in a novice GWT held under KC regulations.
Open: Open to all breeds that Hunt, Point & Retrieve.
- Please Note: No bitches in season will be allowed on the ground
Keep dogs on a lead except under judges' instructions.
Spectators and Competitors must consider themselves under the control of the Stewards at all times. Dogs arriving after the judging has commenced will not be allowed to run without the permission of both judges and organisers.
All dogs must be registered on their BREED register with the KC. The Organisers, CDGS and the Land Owner or his Agent, cannot be held responsible for any loss, damage or accidents that occur on the day however occasioned. Vehicles & dogs are the responsibility of their owners.
- Directions: Take the B4089 Coventry to Tamworth Road, Fivefield Road is approx. half a mile south of Corley, sign posted Keresley – follow the C&DGS signs to the ground.
- Raffle: There will be a Raffle on the day and prizes would be gratefully received.
